
FROM COLLEGE TO THE CLASSROOM

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

ALL SPORTS: Our athletes contribute over 3,500 hours annually in service and outreach. The Lions have earned the Sooner Athletic Conference Scholar Award and the Wheeler Award.

VOLLEYBALL: The Lady Lions secured back-to-back SAC Regular Season Championships in 2023, earning an automatic bid to the NAIA National Tournament.

MEN'S BASKETBALL: Qualified for the NAIA Division I National Tournament for the fifth consecutive year.

MEN'S & WOMEN'S SOCCER: Both teams qualified for the NCCAA, with outstanding performances in the 2023 NCCAA All Central Region Awards.

TRACK & FIELD: A men's track athlete achieved NAIA All-American status after a record-breaking performance in the NAIA National Track & Field Championship heptathlon.


